Explanation of Wildcard - Due to the high number of entries received in certain counties, PDFNJ developed a fair judging process in which those entries that did not receive the highest score in their respective counties, but scored higher than finalists of other counties, are then awarded a "Wildcard" slot. Wildcard performers receive equal judging as County Finalists. In fact a Wildcard was chosen as one of the winners in 2009.
